- Young children learn through play and experimentation and by watching and listening to the grownups they love, but parents don't need to have music skills—they just need a desire to play and have fun with their children!
- Music Together CDs have outstanding arrangements that are fun, sophisticated and loved by children and grownups alike. The music includes a mix of original songs and traditional tunes from the folk, jazz and world music traditions in a variety of tonalities and meters.

TUITION INCLUDES

REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We limit each class to twelve registered children and their accompanying adults and up to two infant auditors who are under 8 months at the start of the session who are siblings of a registered child. We cannot guarantee your first choice of class times, but will do our best to honor your request and your flexibility is appreciated. Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children) will be

anceled and we will do our best to find another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, you will receive a full refund.

UNLIMITED MAKE-UPS Unlimited make-up classes are allowed during the summer session.

UNLIMITED EXTRA CLASSES You are welcome to take as many extra summer classes as you can fit into your schedule—at no extra cost! Use the online Make-Up Scheduler to register.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE/REFUNDS For the eight-week summer session, tuition for the first registered child is \$149 and \$79 for each additional sibling 8 months or older. Infants under 8 months on the first day of the session are free with a paying sibling. All infants are welcome, whether or not they are siblings. Infants get so many benefits from class! There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families registering with Music Together in the Valley for the first time for all locations except our Parks and Rec and Community Ed locations. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of your class. After this, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

MUSIC TOGETHER IN THE VALLEY SUMMER 2017 CLASS SCHEDULE

Our eight-week summer session begins June 19 with no classes July 4. (Stillwater has a seven-week session with Wed classes beginning June 21 and Monday classes beginning June 26.)
