REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We try to limit each class to twelve registered children, their accompanying adults and up to two infant siblings. We cannot guarantee your first choice of class times, but will do our best to honor your request and appreciate your flexibility.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six

children registered) will be canceled and we will do our best to find another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

MAKE-UPS Two make-up classes are allowed within the current session. If more make-ups are needed due to special circumstances, this is possible at the director's discretion.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE For a ten-week session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$189 and \$104 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the fall session (born after July 28, 2019) attend free with a paying sibling. All infants are welcome; if they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is \$189, the same as the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families new to our program. This fee is waived for our Parks and Rec and Community Ed locations. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the spring session, so on or before March 21, 2020. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds are not given. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

MUSIC TOGETHER IN THE VALLEY SPRING 2020 CLASS SCHEDULE

Our 10-week Spring Session begins March 28-April 3. Centerville and Lino Lakes have 8-week spring sessions which begin April 1 and 2 respectively and end May 20 and 21. There are no classes on Easter Sunday, April 12; Sunday classes end June 7. There are no classes on Memorial Day, May 25; Monday classes end June 8. Saturday classes end May 30. Tuesday-Friday classes end June 2-5. All classes listed below are 45 minutes and are mixed-age—for infants, toddlers, preschoolers and their accompanying adults—including those labeled 'Generations' which have the added bonus of the participation of 'grandfriends' who are residents at the senior living facilities where these classes are held.
