- Our research-based curriculum not only develops music skills, it nurtures creativity, self-expression and confidence while also supporting social, emotional, cognitive, language and physical development.
- The family-like setting of Music Together's mixed-age classes enables siblings to participate together, creating an ideal learning environment where infants, toddlers and preschoolers can freely participate at their own levels.
- Music Together song collections have outstanding arrangements that are fun, sophisticated and loved by children and grownups alike. The music includes a delightful mix of both original songs and traditional tunes from the folk, jazz and world music genres in a wide variety of tonalities and meters, providing a rich buffet of 'ear food.'

FALL TUITION INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING, ALL DELIVERED ONLINE VIA ZOOM:

- A live, interactive, 30-minute class each week for ten weeks at your designated class time—which is recorded so you can enjoy it again and again
- Live, weekly 'Musical Play Dates' each Tuesday at 6:30 pm, also recorded
- Live, weekly 'Story and Lullaby Times' each Thursday at 6:30 pm, also recorded
- Saturday night dance parties every other week and a monthly 'Happy Hour' parent education event
- Professionally-recorded digital and CD recordings of the beloved 'Bongos' song collection we'll be working with this fall which includes songs, rhythmic rhymes and tonal and rhythm patterns
- A beautifully illustrated songbook/storybook that welcomes you and your child into the music
- A weekly newsletter with bonus materials such as coloring pages, activity sheets & parent education videos

REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We try to limit each class to 12-14 registered children and their accompanying adults and up to two infant siblings. We cannot guarantee your first choice of class times, but will do our best to honor your request and appreciate your flexibility.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children) will be canceled and we will do our best to find

another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

MAKE-UPS If you miss a class, the recording of it will come to you within a few days, so making up a class is as easy as participating along with the video.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE For a ten-week session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$189 and \$104 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the fall session (born after January 26, 2020) attend free with a paying sibling. All infants are welcome. If they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is \$189, the same as the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families new to our program. This fee is waived for our Parks and Rec and Community Ed locations. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the fall session, so on or before September 19, 2020. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds are not given. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

MUSIC TOGETHER IN THE VALLEY FALL 2020 ONLINE CLASS SCHEDULE

Our 10-week fall session begins September 26–October 2 with no classes Nov 26–29.

All classes listed below are mixed-age classes for infants, toddlers, preschoolers and the grownups who love them, with this exception: 'Rhythm Kids' classes are for K-2nd graders and are Tuesdays at 4 pm.

We are completely online this fall! Yes, our renowned music education program is coming to you, right in the comfort of your very own home. It's safe, convenient, engaging, effective, stress relieving and totally fun. The locations listed below are where classes would have been held if we had been able to hold them safely in person. We encourage you to choose a location near you so that when we are able to return to in-person classes that you'll be able to keep the same teacher and be with the same Music Together families.
