- Our research-based curriculum not only develops music skills, it nurtures creativity, self-expression and confidence while also supporting social, emotional, cognitive, language and physical development. Research shows that music learning supports all learning.
- Our mixed-age classes enable siblings to attend together, creating an ideal learning environment where infants, toddlers and preschoolers can freely participate at their own level.
- Music Together song collections have outstanding arrangements that are fun and sophisticated yet easily accessible—and they are loved by both children and grownups alike. The music includes a delightful mix of both original songs and traditional tunes from both the US and many other countries in a wide variety of tonalities and meters, providing a rich buffet of 'ear food.'

TUITION INCLUDES

- Ten weekly 45-minute classes at the class time and place you've chosen with engaging activities you can do all week long.
- The professionally produced 'Bongos' song collection that you can access using our free 'Music Together' app and/or via the optional CDs we offer. It includes songs, rhythmic rhymes and tonal and rhythm patterns.
- The beautifully illustrated 'Bongos' songbook/storybook that welcomes you and your child into the music.
- 'Music and Your Child: A Guide for Parents and Caregivers,' a booklet-sized crash course in early childhood music development designed to help you help your child get the most out of our classes.
- A growth chart to help you identify and celebrate your child's milestones in music development.
- Parent education to help the adults understand and enhance their children's music development
- The opportunity to meet new friends—both for you and for your child—and to build community.

REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We try to limit each class to 12 registered children and their accompanying adults and up to two free infant siblings.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children) may be canceled and we will do our best to find another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

MAKE-UPS: You are welcome to make up and any all classes

missed for whatever reason and can schedule make-ups using our online Make-Up Scheduler which is under 'Enrolled Families' at MusicTogetherClasses.org. We also offer two bonus video classes each session that you can use for make-ups.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE: For the ten-week fall session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$209 and \$129 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the session (born after Jan 19, 2026), attend at no cost with a paying sibling. All infants are welcome. If they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is \$209, the same as the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families new to our program. This fee is waived for those who register with our Parks and Rec and Community Ed partners. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the session, so on or before Sept 12, 2026. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds will not be given. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.
