TUITION INCLUDES

- Eight weekly 45-minute classes
- A professionally-recorded CD of the class activities: songs, rhythmic rhymes and tonal and rhythm patterns—and a code to digitally download or stream these same materials
- A child-sized songbook/storybook with delightful illustrations that welcomes you to the music.
- “Music and Your Child: A Guide for Parents and Caregivers,” an engaging overview of early childhood music development designed to help you help your child get the most out of our classes.
- Access to the ‘Family Music Zone’ online with videos and activities to enrich your child's music experience
- A chart to help parents and caregivers track children's music growth through Music Together sessions

REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We limit each class to twelve registered children, their accompanying adults and up to two infant siblings. We cannot guarantee your first choice of class times, but will do our best to honor your request and appreciate your flexibility.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children) will be canceled and we will do our best to find

another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

MAKE-UPS Two make-up classes are allowed within the current session. If more make-ups are needed due to special circumstances, this is possible at the director's discretion.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE For a eight-week summer session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$159 and \$79 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the summer session (born after Oct 22, 2018) attend free with a paying sibling. We allow up to two infant auditors per class. Only one infant per family is allowed to come at no cost. All infants are welcome. If they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is the same as the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families registering for the first time for all locations except our Parks and Rec and Community Ed locations. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the winter session, so on or before June 15, 2019. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds are not given. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

MUSIC TOGETHER IN THE VALLEY SUMMER 2019 CLASS SCHEDULE

Our 8-week summer session begins June 22-28 in most of our locations. No classes on July 4 and some locations take off the entire week of July 1. All classes listed below are mixed-age classes for infants, toddlers, preschoolers and their accompanying adults with this exception: classes labeled 'Generations' are mixed-age parent/child classes with the added bonus of the participation of 'grandfriends' who are residents at the senior living facilities where these classes are held.
